

VOTER REGISTRATION

Residents of Lake County may register to vote at our District 41 school offices. The designated Deputy Registrar in the school office is available to register qualified voters during school hours. To qualify to be registered to vote the following conditions must be satisfied:

- Be a United States citizen
- Be 18 years of age by the date of the next election
- On the date of the next election, have resided in the voting precinct for 30 days
- Not be convicted and in jail
- Not claim the right to vote anywhere else
- Produce two forms of identification

Acceptable forms of identification (not expired) with the present legal address include :

- Illinois Drivers license
- Illinois ID card
- Valid Passport
- Utility or contract service bill addressed to applicant at legal address postmarked no more than 30 days
- Personalized check for checking account

Secondary forms of ID include:

- Military, employee, student or welfare ID card
- Certified birth certificate
- Social Security or Veteran's Patient card
- Civic, union or professional membership card
- Library or insurance card
- Naturalization papers

Registration is suspended 27 days before an election and 2 days after an election.

Applications may be completed by mail, if the registration process is finalized before the next election, and the voter must vote in person, not by absentee ballot. The online application can be found at www.lakecountyil.gov/countyclerk
