

Per Governor Pritzker's Disaster Proclamation effective March 9, 2020 through the end of the 2019-2020 school year, the Governor has suspended the requirement that a quorum of the members of a public body be physically present at a board meeting and the conditions which limit when remote participation is permitted.

Public bodies are encouraged to "provide video, audio, and/or telephonic access to meetings to ensure that the public may monitor the meeting." To that end, the Lake Villa School District #41 Board of Education meetings held during the duration of the disaster proclamation related to COVID-19, will be available to the community by visiting website www.district41.org under the LIVESTREAM tab, Board of Education Meeting 4/20/2020.
