LAKE VILLA SCHOOL DISTRICT 41 COVID-19 SELF-SCREENER



All Lake Villa District students and employees must complete the self screening Pass of Consent questions listed below each morning prior to reporting to school.

District 41 is going to operate under the following assumption:

- If an employee decides to come to school that employee is confirming that every response to the following self screening questions is "NO".
- If a student attends school, a parent is confirming that every response to the following self-screening questions is "NO".

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of reported symptoms, ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus.

Have you experienced ANY of the currently known symptoms of COVID-19 below in the past 24 hours?

1. Fever (Temperature greater than 100.4 degrees F/38 degrees C)
2. Cough
3. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
4. Chills
5. Fatigue from unknown cause
6. Muscles or body aches
7. New onset of moderate to severe headache
8. Sore throat
9. New loss of taste or smell
10. New Congestion or runny nose
11. Vomiting
12. Diarrhea
13. Abdominal pain from an unknown cause
14. In the last 14 days; have you had *close contact with or cared for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or that had all the currently known symptoms of COVID-19 that are listed above

If you answer **yes** to any, students and employees should not be on-site and should follow IDPH guidelines for their return.

*Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet of a COVID-19 case for greater than 15 minutes; close contact can occur while caring for, living with, visiting, or sharing a healthcare waiting area or room with a COVID-19 case or having direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (e.g., being coughed on). If the answer is "yes" to any question do not come to school.

ESCUELA DE LAKE VILLA DISTRITO 41 COVID-19 AUTO-EVALUACIÓN



Todos los estudiantes y empleados del distrito de Lake Villa deben completar las preguntas de auto-evaluación que se enumeran a continuación cada mañana antes de presentarse a la escuela.

El Distrito 41 operará bajo el siguiente suposición:

- Si un empleado decide venir a la escuela, ese empleado está confirmando que cada respuesta a las siguientes preguntas de autoevaluación es "NO".
- Si un estudiante asiste a la escuela, los padres están confirmando que cada respuesta a las siguientes preguntas de autoevaluación es "NO".

Las personas con COVID-19 han tenido una amplia gama de síntomas informados, que van desde síntomas leves hasta enfermedades graves. Los síntomas pueden aparecer de 2 a 14 días después de la exposición al virus.

¿Ha experimentado ALGUNO de los síntomas conocidos actualmente de COVID-19 a continuación en las últimas 24 horas?

1. Fiebre (temperatura superior a 100,4 grados F / 38 grados C)
2. Tos
3. Falta de aire o dificultad para respirar.
4. Resfriado
5. Fatiga
6. Dolores musculares y corporales
7. Dolor de cabeza
8. Dolor de garganta
9. Nueva pérdida del gusto u olfato
10. Congestión o secreción nasal.

13. Diarrea
14. En los últimos 14 días; ¿Ha tenido * contacto cercano o cuidado de alguien diagnosticado con COVID-19 o que tenía todos los síntomas conocidos de COVID-19 que se enumeran anteriormente?

Si responde que **SI** a alguna de estas preguntas, los estudiantes y empleados no deben estar en el persona y deben seguir las pautas de IDPH para su regreso.

* El contacto cercano se define como estar dentro de los 6 pies de un caso de COVID-19 durante más de 15 minutos; El contacto cercano puede ocurrir mientras cuida, vive, visita o comparte una sala de espera o sala de atención médica con un caso de COVID-19 o al tener contacto directo con secreciones infecciosas de un caso de COVID-19 (por ejemplo, al toser). Si la respuesta es "sí" a alguna pregunta, no vengas a la escuela.
