

## COVID-19 Incidence Rates for Lake County and District 41

Number of cases per 100,000 people

- Less than 7 per 100K is the target for **In-person Learning**.
- Seven to 14 is the range for **Hybrid Learning**.
- Greater than 14 over seven consecutive days In Lake County will cause a shift back to **Remote Learning** for a minimum of 10 days. (This would be decided in conjunction with guidance from the Lake County Health Department.) In order to return to a Hybrid Model, there needs to be seven consecutive days below 14.
- The zip codes for Lake Villa 41 are presented for comparison purposes.
